The aim of this policy is to convey the group's commitment to minimising this impact through setting achievable objectives, operating responsibly and complying with legislation.

It is the responsibility of all staff to aim to achieve the objectives set by the Group Chairman during day to day activities.

Objectives

- To comply with legislation and local regulations relating to the group's environmental aspects.
- To ensure environmental impact is considered during the design stage of new products reducing waste at the source.
- To prevent air, water and land pollution as far as reasonably practicable.
- To recycle or re-use materials whenever possible.
- To minimise consumption of resources, reducing paper use and heating oil consumption.
- To promote the use of sustainable resources when viable.
- To reduce the use of plastics in packaging.
- To replace old lighting with low energy lighting, switch off lights in areas that are unoccupied or not in use and turn equipment off when not in use overnight.
- To avoid or reduce the use of hazardous substances where possible.
- To ensure emergency spill & containment procedures are in place for hazardous substances.
- To promote environmental awareness, encouraging continual improvement reviews and adoption of new ideas.
- To promote bicycle commuting by providing changing, washing and bicycle storage facilities.
- To promote transport efficiency for equipment and personnel.
- To encourage the group's suppliers and subcontractors to adopt good environmental practices.
- To encourage flora and fauna to thrive in the local ecosystem through bee keeping.

Through continual monitoring of group's activities and as part of the management review, the Group Chairman is responsible for setting the environmental policy annually. The Group Chairman is responsible for providing adequate resources to enable environmental objectives to be achieved.
